




Our next run will be on Wednesday 26th. June and I've made arrangements to go and have a look at "Anson Air Museum" at the Ballarat Airport.

WOOMELANG AUCTION

Woomelang Deceased Estate Auction Report Mr. Glen (Brick) Boxall Collector and Hoarder Extraordinaire All-Around Good Bloke Sunday May 18th

On Saturday May 17th, the Hutchinson's, John and Mark and the Darrell's, Alan and Jake fired up the van and ute, hooked up the trailer and made their way to Birchip, the gateway to the Mallee in readiness for a huge auction that was to be conducted out of Woomelang the very next day. A three hour, or so journey, with the Darrell's taking a long shortcut, and ending up in the home of tractor pulling, Quambatook. After consuming several lagers and walloping down a sumptuous meal at the Birchip pub we all retired for a relatively early night in readiness for the big day ahead.

After the obligatory egg and bacon rolls for breakfast we set sail for Woomelang. Everyone who turned up, and believe me there were hundreds, and hundreds of trailers I reckon; well, at least a hundred trailers had been watching this auction on the Facebook page of Martin Evans the auctioneer appointed to conduct the event. Amazing thing social media. Modern day Bush telegraph I reckon. Awfully cheap, effective advertising compared to conventional methods.

As we rolled into the gate it soon became apparent that this was a MONSTER auction. The pictures below give you some idea of the scale in the background. I've only included pics of the Holden 'cars' and parts that I saw. The remainder was probably 20 times bigger. Once the auction got underway Martin soon pushed the pace. It was hard to get into the inner throng of bidders, but one particular item, certainly calmed everyone's enthusiasm or rather shocked everyone.

The vehicle below, or rather the remains below of a 1948 Landrover topped the sale within the first ten

lots. The bidding gained incredible pace and very quickly halted at \$38,500 plus 15% buyers premium. No, I haven't slipped on the keyboard. I s*&t you not. That was what some Wally paid for it. To be restored and returned to the old country I presume, as it turns out that it is the only remaining numbers-matching 1 of 3 prototype Landrovers that came to Aus before any others to test their ability to stand up to the Australian military, drivers, miners, farmers and anyone else who may be a potential buyers. As the hammer came down I'm sure Martin realized very quickly that ME Auctions had gleaned around \$12k out of this one sale. He didn't have to work too hard for the remaining 459 lots I'm sure, but he did.



More importantly, the Holden cars and parts in the pics varied all over the place.

The red VN had lots of useful bits and a good body. It made a whole \$50 compared to the rusty LX Torana parts car which made \$3850 from memory. P.S. Don't forget to add 15% to the prices I'm quoting though. A V8 HT Kingswood, very good body, pulled up in the mid two thousands, Kevin Igoe picked up a pretty good humpy body quite cheaply, and he didn't have to pay any extra for the modification to the firewall either.

Parts wise, you can see the pair of HD Premier seats suitable for restoration made \$500 plus BP.

The remains and severely abbreviated and ventilated X2 air cleaner on the pallet made \$650 plus BP.

HQ clip with free dents and scrapes on all panels brought \$650 +. The Speco grey motor alloy rocker cover made \$250. If you would like to know any other prices feel free to ask.

Hot items at the sale that made solid money was anything with military heritage eg. Dodge Powerwagons, old Landcruisers, Volkswagens, especially the two Country buggies and Kombi camper, Valiant wrecks were keenly sort after etc etc. ensued.

Even though the weather was very unkind on the day, read that cold, freezing wind, dust storm that didn't stop the hardy. Everyone agreed it had been

a great day out, mainly for social reasons and the number of bidders probably didn't top fifty I reckon. Estimates grossed the day at ca \$160,000. I'm sure the connections would have been happy.

So what did we buy? The Hutchinson's managed to fill the van to the gunnells and the Darrell's seemed to overfill the ute, mainly with Chrysler parts strangely. Score.

We look forward to many more days like that. Good times, good friends and plenty of crap to look at heh heh.






