


You are now on notice to finalise those ISO repairs and maintenance you may have been doing to your Holden and plan to join us on Sunday the 5th of July.









Convertible So good it looks like GMH built it!











The motor is a 1981 Commodore (blue motor with Trimatic Auto) front and rear is lowered 2in. HR front and rear end, G.T. Monroe shocks. Steering is Commodore including the steering wheel and column. Wheels are Classic Wire with P.205-65 HR-13 Tyres. Dash is Commodore with gauges, console and antenna. The top has been chopped 2in. Seats are 1985 Mazda 929 up front and Commodore rear. Tailamps are AP5 Valiant. A Roadsound stereo with 2in TV is fitted. Paint color is Maroon and White. Upholstery is in Red crushed Velvet and red Draylon. Carpet is red cut pile. Trunk is lined concealed battery and panels in Draylon by John Gilbert Upholstery of Kempsey. (the owner). Paint Moultons of Kempsey. Body Gilbert (owner) and Moultons. The Custom work entails lengthening the doors 6in, welded rear sections. Rear fenders have been modified so they can be removed in their entirety. Windows are fully wind up and designed by John. John took weeks of trial and error to get the windows to wind up OK and seal using HQ Holden regulators. Top bows are from an Austin A-40 found at a dump. Doorlocks are LJ Torana. Also fitted is alarm, air conditioning, heater demister, 2 speed Gemini Wipers, Mazda 121 gas tank behind rear seat, Spare is in Mazda 121 wheel well, where original fuel tank was fitted. The NSW D.M.T. sent an engineer up to John's town to inspect and report on the car for registration. A rear recess allows top to be folded in and sit nice and low, out of sight giving a very pleasant line. (Have a look at how high, a new Rolls-Royce convertible top sits when it's down. Ed.) In all John's "Topless" is a very pleasant looking car and one of the best and complete "home brew" convertibles we have seen for a long while.


