Wednesday 28th. July Red Dog Run will meet near Pipers by the Lake at 9:30ish for a Coffee and Catch Up.



We are in uncertain times to organize things due to Covid and sometimes things have to be changed quickly to cope, but we continue to meet when ever possible.


