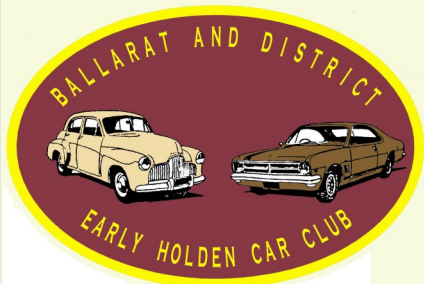

Thank you all for making our club the best!

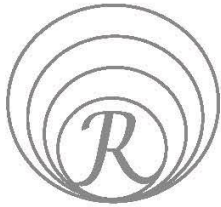

Treasurer's Report: Read by Sandra. Profit and Loss and Balance Sheet provided.
